Factors such as access to health care, information, and economic opportunity can lead to disparities in teen birth rates.

In 2021, the El Paso County birth rate for Hispanic teens was 2.1 times higher than the rate for white teens.




Teen Birth Rate per 1,000 Teens Aged 15-19

Sexually Transmitted Infections

Though teen pregnancy rates are declining, STIs are increasing among Texas youth. Some counties with low rates may simply be providing insufficient access to screening and treatment.
