


In 2021, the Travis County birth rate for Hispanic teens was 12 times higher than the rate for white teens.

Non-Health Social Factors

Structural issues such as poverty and lack of access to health care can contribute to teen pregnancy rates.



Sexually Transmitted Infections Though teen pregnancy rates are declining, STIs

are increasing among Texas youth. Some increase may be due to better screening, but data suggests actual rates are on the rise.
